

Recruitment Methodology

The We the People initiative led by the Napolitan Institute, in partnership with Jigsaw, will run from September 2025 until July 2026. Recruitment and data collection for the program is conducted by the recruitment firm, Rep Data.

Rep Data will recruit a minimum sample of 2175 U.S. citizens, with a minimum of 5 people from each congressional district. The full sample will be representative of the population of U.S. citizens along the dimensions of sex, age, race, and partisan political affiliation.

Demographic targets for sex, age, and race are aligned to the U.S. Census Bureau's <u>2024 Current Population Survey (CPS) Voting and Registration Supplement</u> for the national population of U.S. citizens. Demographic proportions in the final sample may deviate by up to 3% from the targets.
